

## **Village of Arlington Heights**

### **Community Development Block Grant – Covid (CDBG-CV3) Allocation Plan**

#### **Substantial Amendment - 2019 Consolidated Plan Annual Action Plan**

As an entitlement community, the Village of Arlington Heights (“Village”) receives funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Through the CARES Act, the Village has been awarded a total of \$383,860 in Community Development Block Grant – COVID (CDBG-CV 3) funds. These funds must be used by the Village to prevent, prepare for, or respond to the Coronavirus pandemic.

In accordance with the Village’s Citizen Participation Plan and certain HUD regulatory requirement waivers, the Village will undertake the following public participation process for allocating these funds:

#### **Public Hearing #1**

To be held at the Committee of the Whole meeting on Monday, March 8, 2021 beginning at 7:00 pm. Materials on this matter and instructions on how to join the meeting will be available on the Village’s [Agendas & Minutes](#) website page on March 5, 2021.

#### **5-Day Public Comment Period**

To take place from March 10, 2021 – March 14, 2021. A draft of the CDBG-CV3 allocation plan will be available on the Village’s website, [www.vah.com](http://www.vah.com) during the public comment period.

#### **Public Hearing #2 and Adoption by the Village Board**

To take place during the Village Board meeting on Monday, March 15, 2021 beginning at 7:30 pm. Materials on this matter and instructions on how to join the meeting will be available on the Village’s website ([www.vah.com](http://www.vah.com)) on March 12, 2021.

Per HUD’s instructions and the Village’s Citizen Participation Plan, the plan and allocations for the CDBG-CV3 funds will be submitted to HUD as a Substantial Amendment to the Village’s 2019 Annual Action Plan.
