State to Allow Retailers to Provide Curbside Service

Earlier today, Governor Pritzker announced that certain non-essential businesses may provide curbside service to customers beginning tomorrow, May 1, 2020. Regulations do apply, notably:

- Non-essential businesses may only serve customers in order to fulfill phone and online orders for pick-up or delivery.
- Employees must wear face covering within six feet of an employee or customer.
- Customer pick-up should occur outside the store.



The complete executive order, which covers all new information pertaining to non-essential business operations and ongoing stay-at-home requirements, is attached. Please note that these requirements and allowances are State mandates, and not determined by the Village.
