

**ORDER OF THE LOCAL LIQUOR COMMISSIONER OF THE  
VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON HEIGHTS**

As the Governor of the State of Illinois, by Executive Orders issued in response to COVID-19, continues to require all businesses that offer food or beverages for on-premises consumption to suspend service for all on-premises consumption, I am ordering a waiver of requirements for all holders of liquor licenses in the Village which do not currently permit off-premises consumption. Specifically, those license holders may sell alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption in accordance with the following:

1. Alcoholic beverages may be sold only with food orders at curbside pick-up, in-restaurant pick-up, and for delivery.
2. The sale of alcoholic beverages may occur only during the liquor sale hours for the licensed premises as set forth in Section 13-503 of the Arlington Heights Municipal Code.
3. Prior to delivery of any alcoholic beverages by any method, proof of age of the recipient must be verified by the person delivering the alcoholic beverages. As required by Section 13-607 of the Arlington Heights Municipal Code, the individual delivering the alcoholic beverages must be at least 19 years old.
4. Alcoholic beverages may only be delivered in manufacturer's sealed packages **in their original container** (e.g. bottles, cans, boxes). No to-go cups or any kind of unsealed package may be sold.

This Order will remain in effect for the duration of the applicable Executive Orders of the Governor of the State of Illinois, unless otherwise terminated by me.
